

5 REASONS TO LOVE THIS FACILITY

The fertilizer warehouse was completed this past spring and is on the same site as an NH3 facility, fuel depot, chemical warehouse and office facility. The infrastructure investment comes after Kanza Coop acquired this site with its acquisition of Andale Farmers Co-op three years ago.

The team recognized a growing part of the industry is advanced fertilizer products and realized new opportunities would be provided with impregnation in the fertilizer warehouse site plan.
