## 5 REASONS TO LOVE THIS FACILITY

### 1 A SOLID BUILDER PARTNERSHIP

NeuAG and Marcus Construction worked together to design a 70,000 ton AMS storage building, 67,500 sq. ft. bagging warehouse and 34,000 ton NPK storage building. Marcus was the general contractor for NeuAG's state-of-the-art 30-acre greenfield site.

### 2 SERVING MULTIPLE INDUSTRIES

The bagging lines handle AMS turf and consumer products. It packages them in finished bags ranging from 10 lb. to 51 lb. as well as bulk bags ranging from 1,000 lb. to 2,000 lb.



### 3 CUSTOMIZED BLENDING

Blending equipment for bulk truck loadout is rated at 250 tons per hour, so NeuAG can quickly produce large orders of customized blends while maintaining high-quality control standards throughout the process.

### 4 PRODUCT TESTING LAB

Located in the bagging warehouse facility, the lab performs tests on incoming raw materials as well as finished goods before they ship.

### 5 RAIL ACCESS

The facility's ladder track system allows product to be unloaded and loaded to service customers.

#### 24/7 RECEIVING

The truck receiving area for the AMS building operates around the clock to process raw material into three different grades of product.

#### CONNECTED SYSTEMS

The screeners transfer the three product grades to the storage bins using one of four conveyors in the oversized headhouse.

#### EXPANDABLE BAGGING WAREHOUSE

The bagging warehouse features tilt-wall construction and is capable of housing eight bagging lines in a climate-controlled environment.

#### INTEGRATED LAB

The bagging warehouse spans an impressive 67,500 sq. ft. with future expandability options. It accommodates two bagging areas with climate control, storage facilities, office spaces, a product testing lab and loadout docks.

#### NPK BLENDING SYSTEMS

The NPK building has storage capacity of 34,000 tons, divided into eight micro bins. It features a declining weight system and two Continental mixers that supply the bagging warehouse for consumer goods.
