



# **Grain: World Markets and Trade**

### **Grain Corridor Agreement Offers Potential for More Ukraine Exports**





On July 22, 2022, delegations from Ukraine, Turkey, Russia, and the United Nations signed an agreement to provide safe passage for grains from select Ukrainian ports (Odesa, Chornomorsk, Pyvdenny), offering a potential corridor for movement of Ukrainian grain through the Black Sea. This is welcome news for global importers as the expansion of Ukraine's export capacity for corn, barley, and wheat may ease the pressure of high global commodity prices. The benefits for Ukraine are numerous, not least of which is the stimulation of the economy and influx of funds. For Ukrainian producers and exporters, the ability to ship stored grain at the ports that would otherwise be sitting idle, based on the current pace of exports, is significant. Few grain silos in Ukraine are equipped with the aeration systems essential for long-term storage, putting farmers and exporters at risk of losing a significant share of their commodities, and in turn, the capital required for planting next season. While there is cautious optimism about the deal, several roadblocks exist, namely continuing conflict in and around port infrastructure (including transshipment silos), the demining of ports and routes, and persistent high logistical costs related to freight and insurance rates.

Grain exports from Ukraine in the past have been highly seasonal with the largest volumes shipped just after harvest. Barley exports are robust between July and September, and wheat exports are largest between August and November. Corn volumes peak between November and May. Russia's invasion of Ukraine has constrained grain exports this year, leaving larger-than-normal supplies in storage. While exports via land have helped to alleviate the strain on storage capacity, production from the current wheat and barley crops and upcoming corn crop are expected to far exceed domestic consumption needs in a highly export-dependent country. Despite the aforementioned roadblocks to the success of the Black Sea grain corridor, this potential relief valve for Ukrainian grain supplies comes at a timely moment, as exports historically pick up substantially over the next several months. As of this publication, about a dozen ships have left Ukrainian ports, primarily loaded with corn. USDA raised its 2022/23 forecasts for Ukraine corn exports 3.5 million tons to 12.5 million and Ukraine wheat exports 1.0 million tons to 11.0 million this month, in part reflecting expectations of improved export opportunities with the agreement.


## <u>WHEAT</u>

## **OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23**

Global production is forecast up this month primarily on larger crops for Russia, China, Australia, and Canada, more than offsetting reductions for India, the European Union, and Argentina. Global consumption is raised this month, mainly on higher feed and residual use for Australia and Russia. Ending stocks are revised down mostly on a decline for India. Imports are raised on higher imports for Morocco, Algeria, and Turkey. Exports are also up with larger exports from Russia, Australia, Canada, Ukraine, and the United States more than offsetting reductions for the European Union and India. The U.S. season-average farm price is down \$1.25 per bushel to \$9.25.

#### WHEAT PRICES

<u>Domestic</u>: Following the July *WASDE* Report, U.S. quotes declined from the previous month, reflecting a combination of sustained weakness in demand for U.S. wheat and harvest pressure. Hard Red Spring (HRS) declined \$28/ton from last month to \$387/ton as NASS crop condition ratings in North Dakota and Minnesota improved. Hard Red Winter fell \$20/ton to \$377 as the harvest reaches completion. Soft White Winter (SWW) slid \$14/ton to \$374 as the building harvest pressured prices with a larger-than-expected crop. Soft Red Winter (SRW) dropped \$14/ton to \$330 with favorable recent harvest results.



Global: Global wheat prices declined slightly since the July WASDE. EU quotes fell \$18/ton on the declining euro and on the Ukraine safe passage agreement. Russian quotes are the most competitive and have fallen \$21/ton as beneficial weather boosts record production. Canadian quotes slid \$13/ton as much of the crop rates good/excellent after drought conditions in the western portions of the Prairies were alleviated by much-needed rainfall. Australian quotes experienced the largest drop of \$27/ton as continued favorable weather conditions are anticipated to elevate production above the 10-year average. Argentine quotes dropped \$20/ton to be more in line with other countries but Argentina remains the most expensive origin on tight stocks, the result of a robust pace of exports earlier this year.

### International Daily FOB Export Bids






#### **MARKET FEATURE**

### Wheat Production and Exports from Key Suppliers Rebound in 2022/23

Global wheat production is forecast up this month by nearly 8.0 million tons from July to a record 779.6, resulting in a slight year-over-year increase from 2021/22. While China, the world's largest wheat producer, accounts for a portion of this growth, most of the expanded production is concentrated in the major wheat exporting countries.

Russia wheat production is forecast to rebound to a record 88.0 million tons in 2022/23 on improved yields and higher harvested area. With its larger crop and strong demand from importers, Russia is poised to export a record 42.0 million tons this year. Demand has surged for competitively priced wheat from price-sensitive markets in Africa, the Middle East, and Southeast Asia while Ukrainian supplies remain constrained. Russian export quotes have fallen below primary competitors' as the harvest of its bumper crop began in July.

Canada wheat production is expected to rebound from its 2021/22 drought-impacted crop. 2022/23 production is forecast up 62 percent to 35.0 million tons. Canadian export quotes are already relatively affordable prior to the harvest of its spring wheat crop when compared to major competitors United States and Australia. This will allow Canada to recapture market share in its key export destinations in the Western Hemisphere and Asia, with exports forecast to rebound 74 percent to 26.0 million tons.

U.S. wheat production is also forecast to increase this year to 48.5 million tons, but still well below the 10-year production average. The spring wheat crop is forecast to rebound after last year's drought; however, dry conditions in the winter wheat belt have limited overall year-over-year production growth. U.S. wheat exports—forecast up 6 percent to 23.0 million tons—will all experience muted year-over-year growth due to increased competition from Canada.

Other major exporters – the European Union, Australia, Argentina, and Ukraine – will harvest smaller wheat crops in 2022/23. Despite reduced supplies, EU exports are forecast up and Australia exports are unchanged as strong global import demand continues.

## **RICE**


### **OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23**

Global rice production is forecast lower this month, down slightly from last year's record, with reduced production for India and Bangladesh. Global consumption is slightly higher with increases for the European Union and the Philippines. Global stocks are expected to decline mainly due to reductions in India. Imports are forecast down with lower demand from Nepal and Indonesia, only partially offset by higher imports for Bangladesh and the European Union.

### **OVERVIEW FOR 2021/22**

Global rice production is forecast slightly higher this month due to a larger crop in Nepal. Global consumption is up, primarily in India where increased government distributions of rice are compensating for lower wheat distributions. Global stocks are down mostly due to decreases for India, Thailand, and Vietnam. Imports are forecast up due to higher demand from Bangladesh, the Philippines, and Iraq. Exports are forecast slightly higher, primarily for India and Thailand.

#### **RICE PRICES**



In the past month, U.S. quotes rose \$5 to \$710/ton, the highest since 2008, amid tight supplies. Uruguayan prices remain steady at \$545/ton. Thai quotes fell \$12 to \$416/ton due to the harvest of the second crop. Vietnamese prices fell by \$14 to \$396/ton due to weaker demand from the Philippines. Pakistani quotes fell \$44 to \$376/ton on weak demand. Indian quotes rose minimally by \$5 to \$355/ton and remain the lowest globally.

#### **MARKET FEATURE**

### **Bangladesh Imports to Resume with Lower Tariff**

Bangladesh is expected to import rice in large quantities for the next few months, more than doubling the 2022 estimate to 650,000 tons this month. On June 23, the government of Bangladesh reduced the import tariff on rice from 62.5 percent to 25.0 percent, in effect until October 31, 2022. The government is actively allocating import permits to private importers.

Rice is a staple food in Bangladesh and the country is largely self-sufficient in most years. Despite being the third largest rice producer globally, Bangladesh imports sporadically and can have a significant impact on global rice trade. The government adjusts the tariffs to spur imports to help keep domestic prices affordable when crops are smaller. The recent cut in the tariff rate is to help lower rising domestic prices due to a smaller forecast 2022/23 crop and high transportation costs that have contributed to inflation.

In past years, Bangladesh has similarly lowered tariff rates to offset smaller crops. For example, during January to April and August to October 2021, the Bangladesh government reduced tariff rates to 25 percent, resulting in nearly 2.7

million tons of imports. The main supplier was India due to competitive prices and abundant supplies. Bangladesh is again expected to import from India during the time of the reduced tariffs. Wholesale rice is currently \$570/ton in Bangladesh compared to \$335/ton for rice from India. With the 25 percent tariff, India rice would be entering the country at \$419/ton, much lower than Bangladesh's domestic rice prices.

So far this year, Bangladesh has imported just 24,000 tons from January through June. With reduced tariffs through October, imports are expected to surge during the next 4 months.

## **COARSE GRAINS**

### **OVERVIEW FOR 2022/23**

Global corn production is forecast down as crop reductions for the European Union, Serbia, and the United States exceed gains for Ukraine, Turkey, Russia, and Malawi. Global imports are up on a higher forecast for the European Union. Global exports are up with larger forecasts for Russia, Serbia, and Ukraine more than offsetting a reduction for the European Union and the United States. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$6.65 per bushel.

### **OVERVIEW FOR 2021/22**

Global corn production is forecast up with increases for the European Union, Malawi, and Bolivia. Global exports are also forecast up with gains for Ukraine, Serbia, and the European Union. Global imports are forecast down with cuts to Algeria, Morocco, South Korea, and Vietnam exceeding larger imports for Canada. The U.S. season-average farm price is unchanged at \$5.95 per bushel.


#### **CORN PRICES**

Since the July WASDE, major exporters' bids have been a mixed bag. U.S. bids were down \$19/ton to \$299. Argentine bids were little changed, down just \$1/ton to \$274. Brazilian bids were up by \$7/ton to \$290. Demand for Brazilian corn appears to be strong and shipped volumes in August could be record or near-record high. Ukrainian bids remain unpublished. The opening of the grain corridor in the Black Sea is expected to infuse the world with some additional Ukrainian grain supplies, but uncertainty remains regarding potential volumes beyond the initial burst of shipments.



#### **MARKET FEATURE**

### **Taiwan Imports Record Amounts of Corn from South Africa**



2021/22 Taiwan corn imports from South Africa already reach just over 650,000 tons between October 2021 and May 2022, more than double last year's annual total from the market. Imports to date (Oct 2021 to May 2022) are 3.0 million metric tons, nearly unchanged from the same period a year ago.

Taiwan corn production is limited, and the country relies on corn imports to meet industry feed demand for pork and poultry production. This demand has been stable in recent years – Taiwan imported 4.5 million tons in 2019/2020 and 4.3 million in 2020/21. High agricultural commodity and freight prices have not deterred the rate of Taiwanese corn imports due to continuing demand for animal products locally, and subsequently corn imports are forecast at 4.4 million tons in 2021/22.

Taiwan's main suppliers for corn imports are Argentina, Brazil, and the United States. However, in 2020/21, severe drought conditions in Brazil led to low levels of corn production and consequently lower exports. Brazil corn exports in 2020/21 to destinations in Asia were down significantly on the account of rising prices and higher shipping costs. Brazil corn exports to Taiwan dropped to 1.7 million tons in 2020/21, compared to 2.8 million tons in 2019/20.

Year to date 2021/22, Taiwan corn imports from the United States are at 412,000 tons – around 9 percent of imported corn volume. This stands in comparison to the same period in 2020/21 where imports from the United States were at 1.3 million tons – nearly a third of total imported corn volume. Outstanding sales to Taiwan from the United States are at nearly 45,000 tons for the remainder of 2021/2022, and sales for 2022/23 are just 4,505 tons.

In South Africa, record high corn prices and high stocks from 3 consecutive bumper crops ensured a favorable environment for exports. In addition to ample supplies, South African corn prices are competitive against other major exporters to Taiwan currently at \$350/ton. These price factors likely led to a surge in imports to meet feed demand in 2021/22.

<u>Stocks:</u> Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

<u>Consumption</u>: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in local marketing year imports and local marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

<u>Trade</u>: All PSD tables are balanced on the different local marketing years. All trade tables contain Trade Year (TY) data which puts all countries on a uniform, 12-month period for analytical comparisons: wheat is July/June; coarse grains, corn, barley, sorghum, oats, and rye are Oct/Sept; and rice is calendar year (TY 2022/23 corresponds to Jan – Dec 2023).

#### **EU Consolidation:**

Effective January 1, 2021, the separation of the United Kingdom (UK) from the European Union (EU) was complete, including trade between both entities. Starting in May 2021 with the release of 2021/22 data, field crops PSDs reflect EU27 (shown in the PSD system as "European Union") and UK separately.

Beginning with the release of 2021/22 data, historical data for both EU27 and the UK are provided for 5 years (2016/17 through 2020/21). The trade figures starting from 1999/00 through 2015/16 represent the European Union (EU27 plus UK) and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria, Romania, and Croatia, exists only prior to 1999/00.

(2) Rice trade statistics include rough (100610), brown (100620), milled (100630), and broken (100640) on a milled-equivalent basis (rough rice is multiplied by 0.7 and brown rice is multiplied by 0.875).
